Does brake grease provide any benefit?

If used correctly, the answer is yes.

Proper mechanical and hydraulic function is the basis for correctly working brakes and minimum noise. The correct use of brake grease ensures the optimum performance of the brake system.

DO NOT apply grease all over the pads with a brush as is so often the case.

Under no circumstances must the grease come into contact with the friction material. Apply sparingly on both sides of anti-squeal shims, backs and edges of backing plates and pad retaining pins. Avoid contact with the piston, dust covers and any part which comes into contact with Brake Fluid.
