WE Core Returns

Please remember the following when returning Blue Print core:

The majority of Blue Print alternators, brake calipers and starter motors are exchange units that carry a surcharge cost. Surcharge credits will be issued upon receipt of the old unit providing the unit is complete and suitable for re-manufacturing.

A credit will only be issued if:

- The unit returned must be the same part/application as supplied and not substituted for a 'similar' part.
- The unit returned must be drained of oil/fluid and be complete, undamaged and not dismantled.

Below are examples of core returns that are unacceptable for return:

- (6) Dismantled
















Starter Motors
