

SPLIT DECISION



THE DANGERS OF REPLACING A BOOT

A split boot means there is a high chance that the joint will have suffered unseen damage due to the ingress of contaminants.

Water will cause corrosion to the ball pin resulting in rapid wear.

Contaminants such as grit and road salt will produce an abrasive paste causing rapid wear of the ball pin and seat.

Road salt will also hasten the rusting process and speed up joint failure.
