

Vauxhall Vectra 1.9 CDTi Models

This bulletin is to clarify the information required to correctly identify the Rep Set, Concentric Slave Cylinder and Dual Mass Flywheel fitted to these vehicles. Unfortunately the information required is not usually included on VRM look up databases.

The additional information required...

- 1 Engine code
- 2 Gearbox type

The information can be found on a sticker in the engine compartment as shown below.





Location of sticker Information required. This is also duplicated on the timing belt cover.

Engine code Z19DT Gearbox type M32

Alternatively if this sticker is missing or illegible a visual difference between the two gearboxes can be found. The M32 gearbox uses a 20 spline input shaft and the differential assembly can be removed from the gearbox. The F40 gearbox uses a 23 spline input shaft and the differential assembly is contained within the gearbox casing.
