

## The Problem

Valeo Warranty have had some beep and park kits returned due to problems with sensors not detecting objects or being too sensitive and activating the alert when there is no object in range. After inspecting the returned items it has come to light the sensors supplied in the kit have been painted.

The Valeo beep and park kits that include non-paintable sensors are:

632000 – Kit 1    632001 – Kit 2    632002 – Kit 3  
632003 – Kit 4    632004 – Kit 5    632015 – Kit 6 (LCV)

## The Cure

**Valeo do not recommend the sensors supplied in the beep and park kits be painted as this can affect the sensitivity of the units.**

If the user does wish to have the sensors painted to match the colour of their vehicle, specially designed, paintable sensors are available separately. They are listed with part number 632014.

**Valeo warranty will not accept claims for beep and park kits when the sensors supplied have been painted.**
