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
WARNING

- Disconnect all power sources from the vehicle and wait for at least 10 seconds before starting work on the airbag.
- The airbag contains an explosive charge. Do not perform any other work besides that described here.
- Carry the airbag with the metal casing facing away from your body.

Work description

- 1. Turn the wheels to the straight-ahead position.
- 2. Undo the signal cap screws, two Torx T30, at an angle from below, and remove the signal cap.

Disconnect the airbag connector.¹



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
^{1.} Airbag with signal cap.


3. Separate the connector from the clock spring.








- 4. Remove the protective casings under the instrument panel and around the steering column.
- 5. Undo the steering wheel centre bolt and remove the steering wheel.








- 6. Detach the connector and remove the clock spring. It is secured by 3 mounting lugs, which are pressed inwards for removal.
- 7. Remove the direction indicator, windscreen wiper and retarder/Opticruise levers.







- 8. Remove any steering wheel angle sensors.
- 9. Undo the starter lock and the transceiver connectors.
- 10. Cut away the cable harness clamping.
- 11. Remove the joint screw.







- 12. Separate the joint by drawing the lower steering column downwards.
- 13. Press the steering column down as far as it will go.
- 14. Drain the air system.








Work description

15. Remove the air hose.







- 16. Remove the 4 screws which secure the steering column in place. These are accessible from underneath when the steering column is in its collapsed position.
- 17. Draw the steering column obliquely upwards and out.
